

Field Trip Liability Release and Indemnity Agreement

By signing this form, you are releasing the Vancouver Audubon Society, its officers and directors, and _____ (field trip leader) from any and all liability in the event you are injured or killed while participating in any field trip sponsored by the Vancouver Audubon Society.

I wish to participate in one or more field trips sponsored by the Vancouver Audubon Society (VAS). I am aware that field trips sponsored by VAS may involve certain dangers, including, but not limited to, the hazards of traveling and walking in undeveloped and natural areas, transportation by private vehicle, injury or illness in remote places without medical aid, and unforeseen events caused by the forces of nature. In consideration for permitting me to participate in field trips sponsored by VAS, I, for my family, my estate, and myself, hereby waive any right of recovery and claims of liability against VAS, its board members and volunteers, including claims for bodily injury, including death, personal injury and/or damage to property, and release VAS, its board members and volunteers from such claims and any claims made by others for personal injury or property damage allegedly caused by me. Further, I will hold VAS harmless from any loss or damages resulting from the foregoing waiver and release.

Mandatory Guidelines for Covid-Safe Field Trips

The undersigned also agrees to comply with these guidelines that apply to everybody on the field trip:

- Stay home if you, or a member in your household, have any symptoms, or if you have been in contact with anyone with these symptoms:
 - ✓ Fever, chills, or muscle/body aches
 - ✓ Cough
 - ✓ Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - ✓ Fatigue
 - ✓ Headache
 - ✓ New loss of taste or smell
 - ✓ Sore throat
 - ✓ Congestion or runny nose
 - ✓ Nausea or vomiting
 - ✓ Diarrhea
- Drive on your own, or with members of your household. At your own risk and discretion, you may drive with others if all are vaccinated, face masks are worn, and mutually agreed upon by the riders.
- Bring your own scope and avoid sharing. If sharing, sanitize eye piece and maintain social distancing.
